

I-75 and 951 (Collier Blvd.) Utility Relocation Project

There will be a temporary detour on City Gate Drive associated with the I-75 and 951 (Collier Blvd.) Utility Relocation Project. From Tuesday, September 8 to Monday, September 14, 2020, City Gate Drive, between Collier Blvd. and White Lake Blvd., will be closed to eastbound traffic while crews install underground utilities.

Business access is at City Gate Boulevard North.

To access White Lake Blvd. from Collier Blvd., motorists should use City Gate Blvd. North and turn right on White Lake Blvd. Traffic will be reduced to one lane in each direction at the intersection of City Gate Drive and White Lake Blvd.

To exit White Lake Blvd. motorists should turn on City Gate Drive and turn north or south on Collier Blvd.

Construction will occur from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m. every day, except Sunday. This schedule may change due to inclement weather.

This Collier County project will relocate existing water mains, install new water mains and provide utility improvements. The work is taking place in advance of construction at the I-75 interchange by the Florida Department of Transportation.
